

# Horse Worming & Vaccination Schedule

The five most common dewormer ingredients found in horse wormers are: Febendazole, Ivermectin, Moxidectin, Praziquantel, and Pyrantel.

**Febendazole** controls large strongyles, encysted early- and late-third-stage and fourth-stage cyathostome larvae, small strongyles, pinworms, and ascarids. Horse dewormers that contain Febendazole include:

*Safe-Guard Paste*  
*Panacur*

**Ivermectin** controls large strongyles, small strongyles, pinworms, ascarids, hairworms, large-mouth stomach worms, bots, lungworms, and intestinal threadworms. Horse dewormers that contain Ivermectin include:

*Generic Ivermectin*  
*Equimectrin*  
*Equell*  
*Zimecterin*

**Praziquantel** controls tapeworms. Horse dewormers that contain Praziquantel include:

*ComboCare*  
*Zimecterin Gold*  
*Equimax*

**Pyrantel Pamoate and Tartrate** control large strongyles, small strongyles, pinworms, ascarids, and tapeworms when double-dosed.

Horse dewormers that contain Pyrantel Pamoate and Tartrate include:

*Generic Pyrantel*  
*Exodus Paste*  
*Strongid*

**January OR February** - *Oxibendazol or Fenbendazole*  
Panacur (Fenbendazole) - Recommended

**March OR April** - *Ivermectin/Praziquantel*  
Zimecterin Gold - Recommended

**May OR June** - *Pyrantel Pamoate*  
Strongid - Recommended

**July OR August** - *Oxibendazol or Fenbendazole*  
Anthecide EQ (Oxibendazole) - Recommended

**September OR October** - *Ivermectin/Praziquantel*  
Equimax - Recommended

**November OR December** - *Pyrantel Pamoate*  
Strongid - Recommended

## DOSAGE:

The Recommended BRANDS are just our preference and what your mini has been getting, you may use any BRAND of wormer you choose, just look for the clinical name (listed beside the months).

Worm every two months according to rotation schedule above.

6 months - 3 years - 300lb

3 years & up - 600lb (unless mini is very small, is so, continue with 300lb dosage)

## Vaccinations:

Start at 6 months - per vet's instructions
